Wind	Security and stability of displays and large objects	 All stallholders must ensure their displays are weighted down adequately All freestanding displays and racks must also be secured and adequately weighted. Rain	Slippery surfaces / Damage to property for bump in and out	 In the event of rain and showers, all stallholders are responsible for ensuring their products are safe for bump in and bump out. If inclement weather is forecast alternative set-up arrangements may be actioned.

Trip Hazard	Vendor products	 All stallholders must ensure that all egress routes are clear, pathways between stalls are clear and materials and signage are not obstructing any pathways. All stallholders must ensure that they have sufficient lighting in their stall for the safety of their customers as well as their own.

Should there be cause to evacuate the immediate area, stallholders must do so calmly and immediately, under the guidance of the Distillery Road Market team and emergency services. The evacuation point for the Market Hall is the Southern Carpark or Western Carpark depending on the incident In the event of an evacuation, stallholders must not pack down their stock. All stalls must be left unattended.
Bomb threat	Identified as in or around the Distillery Road Market precinct	 Should there be cause to evacuate the immediate area, stallholders must do so calmly and immediately under the guidance of the Distillery Road Market team and emergency services. The evacuation point for the Market Hall is the Southern Carpark or Western Carpark depending on the incident In the event of an evacuation, stallholders must not pack down their stock. All stalls must be left unattended.
Civil Disorder	Involving public demonstrations either by a group or individual identified in or around the Distillery Road Market precinct	Stallholders must report any civil disorder immediately to the BrisStyle market crew.
Electrical Failure	Identified as in Distillery Road Market precinct	Stallholders must report any electrical failure immediately to the BrisStyle market crew.

Emergency Evacuation General	An emergency situation requiring the removal of people from one given area to another	 All stallholders must remain calm, leave their stalls immediately and follow the onsite Distillery Road Market Security or emergency services to the evacuation point. The evacuation point for the Market Hall is the Southern Carpark or Western Carpark depending on the inciden In the event of an evacuation, stallholders must not pack down their stock. All stalls must be left unattended.
Emergency Invacuation	An emergency situation requiring the need to confine people to an enclosed area. Ie: Extreme weather conditions, armed assaults etc.	 All stallholders must remain calm, leave their stalls immediately and follow the onsite Distillery Road Market Security or emergency services to the evacuation point. Stallholders must not pack down their stock. All stalls must be secured and left unattended.
Fire	Identified as in or around the Distillery Road Market precinct	 Stallholders must report any suspicious smoke or fire immediately to the BrisStyle market crew. Should there be cause to evacuate the immediate area, stallholders must do so calmly and immediately, under the guidance of the Distillery Road Market security or emergency services. The evacuation point for the Market Hall is the Southern Carpark or Western Carpark depending on the incident Stallholders must not pack down their stock. All stalls must be left unattended. Stallholders must be vigilant of emergency service vehicles entering the site.
Lost Child / Missing Persons	Identified as in or around the Market Hall	Stallholders must report any lost child or missing person immediately to the BrisStyle market crew.
Medical Emergencies	Identified as in or around the Market Hall	Stallholders must call 000 for any major medical emergency immediately and contact the onsite BrisStyle market crew.
Suspicious Items	Identified in or around The Distillery Road Market Precinct	 Stallholders must report any suspicious items immediately to the BrisStyle market crew. Do Not Touch The Item Avoid radio and mobile phone use in

On-Site Incident	Identified as in the Distillery Road Market Precinct	 A First Aid Kit is located at the BrisStyle Promo stand. A Defibrillator is located in the site office near the market hall. Stallholders must report any accidents immediately to the BrisStyle market crew and follow the instructions of the Distillery Road Market Security team
